Cold Weather Training will be held March 11-13 at Lost Lake Scout Camp. Registration will be \$ 35 and must be in and paid to the Earl and Pat Cook Service Center no later than March 5<sup>th</sup> at 5 PM or the registration cost will increase to \$45. Check in at Lost Lake will begin at Noon on the 11th and all participants must be present no later than 1 PM. This training is an introduction to how we as Boy Scouts continue our outdoor adventure in the cold winter months in the arctic. Most of Thursday will be in classroom sessions but Friday and Friday night will involve being outside so be prepared. Friday night will involve an outdoor campout in winter conditions, if you do not currently own winter gear you will be able to stay in a cabin. Saturday morning will follow up, warm up and clean up from the training before leaving, the course will be over at noon on Saturday.
