- 10:30 p.m. Troop quiet time

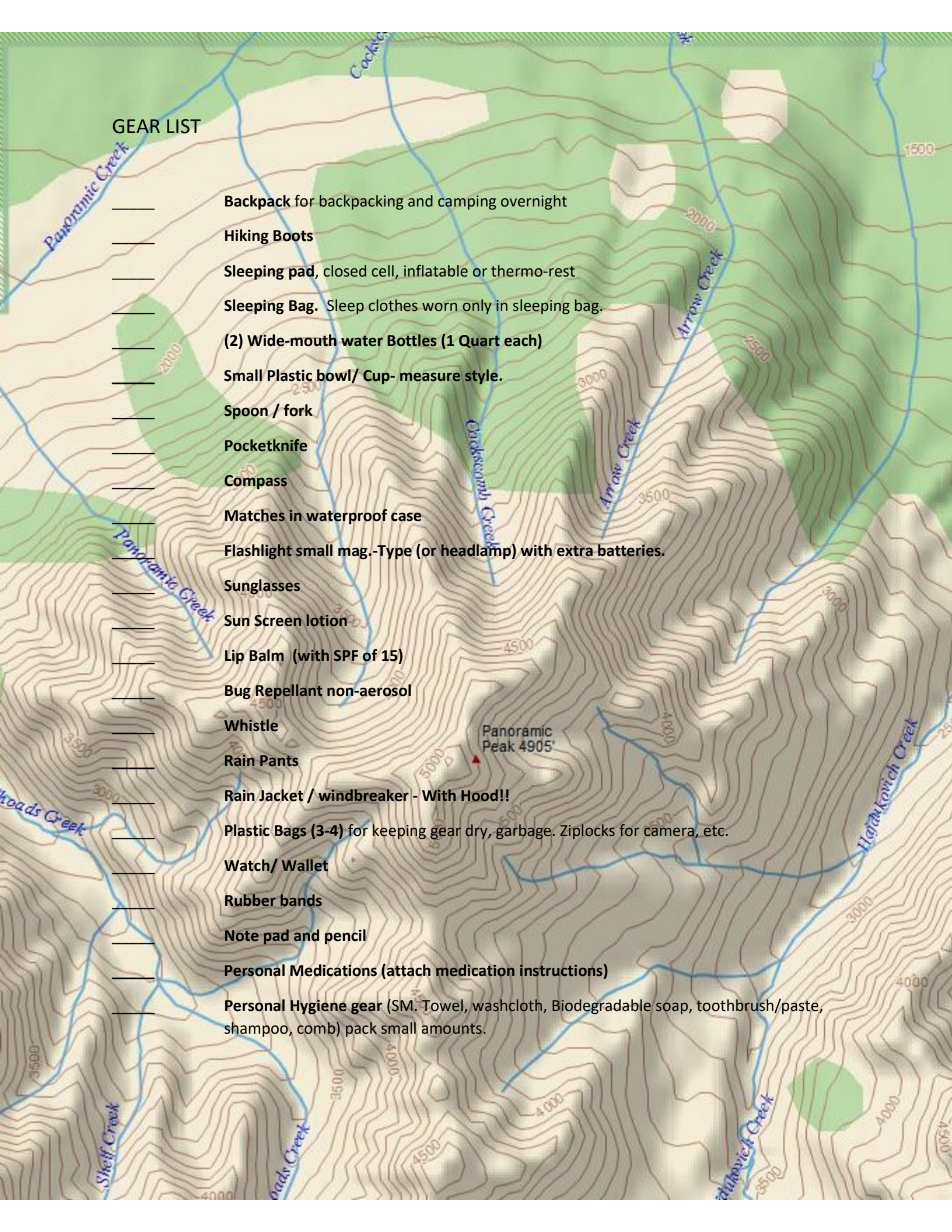

## GEAR LIST

- \_\_\_\_\_ **Backpack** for backpacking and camping overnight
- \_\_\_\_\_ **Hiking Boots**
- \_\_\_\_\_ **Sleeping pad**, closed cell, inflatable or thermo-rest
- \_\_\_\_\_ **Sleeping Bag**. Sleep clothes worn only in sleeping bag.
- \_\_\_\_\_ **(2) Wide-mouth water Bottles (1 Quart each)**
- \_\_\_\_\_ **Small Plastic bowl/ Cup- measure style.**
- \_\_\_\_\_ **Spoon / fork**
- \_\_\_\_\_ **Pocketknife**
- \_\_\_\_\_ **Compass**
- \_\_\_\_\_ **Matches in waterproof case**
- \_\_\_\_\_ **Flashlight small mag.-Type (or headlamp) with extra batteries.**
- \_\_\_\_\_ **Sunglasses**
- \_\_\_\_\_ **Sun Screen lotion**
- \_\_\_\_\_ **Lip Balm (with SPF of 15)**
- \_\_\_\_\_ **Bug Repellant non-aerosol**
- \_\_\_\_\_ **Whistle**
- \_\_\_\_\_ **Rain Pants**
- \_\_\_\_\_ **Rain Jacket / windbreaker - With Hood!!**
- \_\_\_\_\_ **Plastic Bags (3-4) for keeping gear dry, garbage. Ziplocks for camera, etc.**

- \_\_\_\_\_ (1) Warm Jacket (polar fleece is good.)
- \_\_\_\_\_ (2) pair hiking socks of which one pair is a light inner sock
- \_\_\_\_\_ (2) changes underwear
- \_\_\_\_\_ (2) long Pants (1 pair not jeans, i.e. lightweight)
- \_\_\_\_\_ (2) Shirts long sleeve of light wool, fleece, or synthetic.
- \_\_\_\_\_ (2) Shirts short sleeve.
- \_\_\_\_\_ Uniform shirt
- \_\_\_\_\_ Neckerchief
- \_\_\_\_\_ Neckerchief slide
- \_\_\_\_\_ Scout Handbook
- \_\_\_\_\_ Bandana

**Each Buddy Pair must also have**

- \_\_\_\_\_ Tent, one 2-man tent for each two to three campers (Crew)
- \_\_\_\_\_ Nylon or plastic Ground cloth for tent

- \_\_\_\_\_ 8 & 6 quart pot with lid to boil water / wash.

- \_\_\_\_\_ Hot-pot tongs, 2 big spoons, spatula
- \_\_\_\_\_ Plastic trash bags
- \_\_\_\_\_ dish soap
- \_\_\_\_\_ scrub pad, sponge
- \_\_\_\_\_ Food Bag
- \_\_\_\_\_ Toilet paper
- \_\_\_\_\_ Blanket or tarp – 8' x 12'
