WHAT ABOUT THE BAGS?

The Fairbanks Heavy Haulers, a group of dedicated volunteers, will pick up bags left at intersections and along main streets on **May 5** only.

Please **DO NOT** leave bags by the road **AFTER** May 5.
They will not be picked up.

Where to take your bags after Clean Up Day:



The Fairbanks North Star Borough has waived tipping fees for all Clean Up Day trash collected in yellow bags between April 1 and May 31.



Recyclables can be taken to the Fairbanks North Star Borough Central Recycling Facility on May 5. All recyclables will have to be sorted as explained below.

What can we put in the green bags?



On Clean Up Day, the Central Recycling Facility will accept **ONLY** aluminum cans and plastic #1 bottles and plastic #2 jugs in the green bags.
