REGISTRATION: Please fill out the Pack registration forms included and collect Individual registration forms or have parents turn them into the MSC scout office if needed.

WHO CAN ATTEND:

- Scouts that will be 5 years of age / entering Kindergarten in the fall (Lion) through 11 years of age and entering 5th grade (Webelo/Arrow of Light).
- Adults volunteering: We strongly encourage adults to find day care for their younger children. If this is not possible, please include them as tag-a-longs on your Pack form and include BSA Health form and individual registration form for each child.
- Please be aware that Day Camp is a Cub Scout activity, and some Tag-a-longs may not have the abilities to participate in some stations as they are created for scouts 6-11 years old. Tag-a-longs, Lions, and Tigers must stay with parent or guardian.

COST:

Before May 18th: Cub Scouts Lions or older - \$75 fee
Tag-a-longs - \$50 fee

After May 18th: Cub Scout Lions or older - \$85 fee
Tag-a-longs - \$60 fee

LEADERS: DAY CAMP GUIDELINES

- All leaders and parents attending Camp must complete Youth Protection Training every year. Print and attach a copy of the certificate to your registration.
 - Encourage children to be attentive and listen to the instructors. You oversee your group's behavior.
 - No Sandals or open toed shoes.
 - Be Prepared: Dress for the weather.
 - Bring a pop-up shelter to use as your group's base and to protect from sun and rain.
 - Remain with your group for the entire camp day and make sure two adults stay until the last child is picked up.
 - Take attendance each morning.
 - Instruct the children to not go anywhere without a buddy and informing a leader.
 - If a child is missing find out who saw him or her last, what they were wearing and where they were seen. Then report to the Camp Director.
 - Report all injuries to the Camp Health Officer.
 - Be sure children always use the buddy system.
 - Don't let the children run in camp, be safe!
 - Birch Hill does not allow smoking.
 - Make sure children are respectful to others, nature, and property.
 - Be sure there is no littering.
 - Medications must be dispensed by Health Officer or parents. (Exception is personal emergency items.) All medication distributed must be logged by Health Officer.
 - Bring a lunch, snacks, and water for yourself (only staff members may refill bottles.) You may bring snacks for your group if you wish. Food is not provided.
 - Be positive. (No yelling, swearing, degrading or name calling.)
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- Please be sure all Lions and Tigers have Adults present at the camp. Adults need to be registered and have Youth Protection Training completed (valid one year from date of training completed).
 - All [Health forms A/B](#) for scouts and adults attending Day Camp need to be submitted with Pack registrations
 - If Parents would like to pay by credit card, they can pay over the phone at the scout office or visit them in person, once the Pack form has been turned in.

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WHAT TO EXPECT AT CAMP

Cub Scout Day Camp is focused on providing a fun, engaging, and learning experience for our cubs. The scouts and leaders look forward to favorites like crafts, BB guns, archery, science experiments and much more! This camp is open to all Cub Scouts so the entire pack can attend, however, it is best suited for those entering Tiger up to Webelos. These are generally those children entering first grade to those attending fifth grade in the fall. Our Cub Scout Day camp is open to members of the Boy Scouts of America.

There will be opportunities for scouts to complete adventure requirements at stations, however this is optional.

Scout Day Camp has a theme that is incorporated into everything we do. Scout should be prepared to participate in a series of activities and challenges throughout their time at camp.
