

Safety Corner

Two recently published [safety moments](#) that focus on the dangers and possible tragic consequences of unsupervised activity are now available. You may use them in your meetings, newsletters and publications to highlight the importance of Scouting's buddy system and two-deep adult supervision [requirements](#) that exist both to prevent abuse and safeguard against tragedy.

- Adult leaders emphasize the buddy system in unit planning and training activities.
- Adults supervise youth activities.
- Two-deep adult supervision by registered adult leaders 21 years of age or over are required for all Scouting activities.
- This includes patrol activities. These enhanced requirements have been in effect since October 2018.
