Friends of Scouting Board Campaign 2021

The board has been hard at work finding “fuel” to power the Scouts rocket to the moon.

This STEM themed fundraiser started early in December 2020 with a Scout rocket launch date of 1 June....Well we are all finding out that fuel caches are hard to find! The Scouts are not discouraged as they have some pre-launch glitches to solve before they can launch anyway (something about a faulty fuel gauge).

Let us use this bit of time to get them what they need to accomplish their objective! The launch date has been pushed back 30days to July 1st in hopes that they can clear the glitches and we can secure the remaining fuel they need to get to the moon.

The board campaign is currently at 66% of the fuel we need which is 36,334 gallons out of 55,000 gallons. Congratulations to all teams for the hard work they are putting in. Thank you so much for supporting our youth and volunteers!

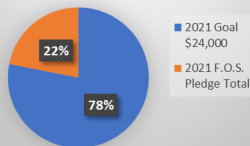

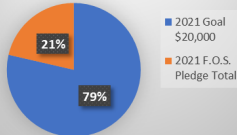

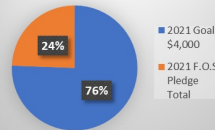

The **Tanana Valley District** has raised \$4,278 towards the District Goal of \$20,000

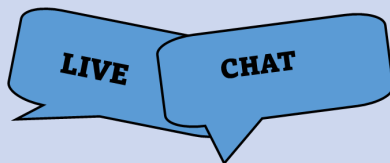
Bush District

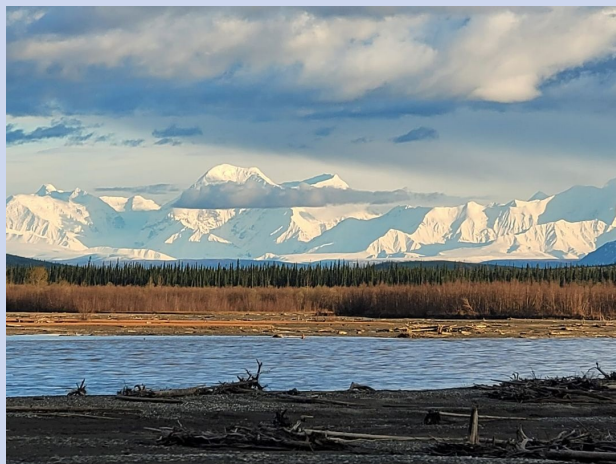


The Tanana Valley District is looking for volunteers to serve as Unit Commissioners!
